- II. **Absences.** All persons selected to participate in the Leadership Academy are expected to fulfill all the obligations indicated above. Recognizing that sometimes circumstances occur that make attendance difficult, the following guidelines will apply.

It shall be the responsibility of the participant to communicate, in writing, all anticipated and/or actual full or partial day absences to the Chairperson of the Leadership Academy, along with an explanation of the circumstances. If this expectation is not met, the applicant, after review, may be dropped from the program with no refund in tuition.

TIME MISSED:	TIME CALCULATED
1. Less than or equal to two hours	25% of a Day or Session
2. Greater than two hours, but less Than or equal to four hours	50% of a Day or Session
3. Greater than four hours, but less Than or equal to five hours	75% of a Day or Session
4. In excess of five hours	100% of a Day or Session

The accumulation of 100% will result in the participant being dropped from the program with no refund of tuition.

## TUITION

If accepted into the Triangle REALTOR® Leadership Academy, you or your broker/sponsor will be responsible for the tuition fee of \$600, which covers all program costs.
